



## Global College Summer Program in Costa Rica Dewitt Wallace Youth Travel Scholarship Application

This 4 week Summer Program, which runs from Thursday, June 25 to Friday, July 24, 2009, will allow students to study and earn six credits toward their undergraduate studies at the Global College Costa Rica center. **This program is designed to give students and overview of the critical peace, reconciliation and environmental issues in Costa Rica through a combination of classroom seminars, experiential learning, cultural immersion and self-study, labs and Spanish language training.** Three weekend field trips to different parts of Costa Rica are included in the program. The total cost of the entire program, including tuition, room/board, airfare, books, field trips, and spending money is approximately \$7200. This scholarship will cover 70% of the costs—student contribution is approximately \$2200.

*\*This scholarship application is open to all Long Island University, LaGuardia Community College, Kingsborough Community College, Nassau Community College and Suffolk Community College students with a 3.0 academic average and whose average annual family income is less than \$75,000. Applicants must submit a copy of their SAR with application. All eligible candidates must also demonstrate that they are capable of raising the required \$2200 not covered by the scholarship.*
