This program will allow students to study abroad at the center of their choice, becoming immersed in their host culture's traditions and history while earning credits toward their undergraduate degrees. The program is designed to give students first hand experience in areas of the world that interest them, offering experiential learning, cultural immersion and self-study, cultural events and language training. Field trips for cultural study to different parts of students' host country are included in the program.
