PRE PROFESSIONAL PHASE

The School of Nursing requires that students complete and pass all Liberal Art & Science classes listed below before beginning the professional phase of the program.

To remain in good academic standing, as a nursing major, students must maintain a 2.75 overall GPA. In addition, a grade of D in a required science course is unacceptable. The courses must be repeated with a grade of C+ or better earned.

The Nelson Denny or TOEFL exam must be taken prior to enrollment in nursing course. A minimum score of a 9 must be achieved for the Nelson Denny Exam and 175 scored for the TOEFL exam. Take your test early. Call the Testing Center to make an appointment at 718-488-1019.

A student's program of study may be extended if the student is placed in proficiency mathematics, biology and the English Department Writing Program (English 13, English 14, Math (DSM 01 or DSM 09))
